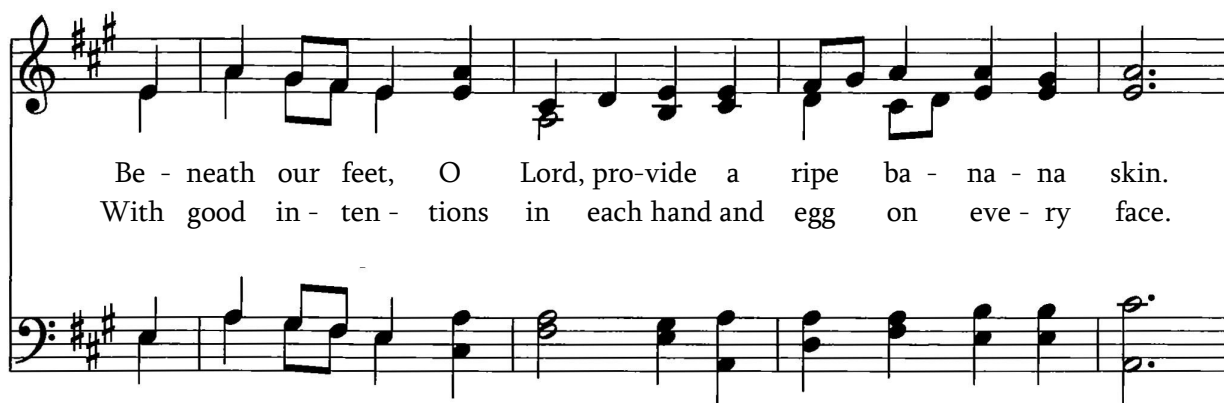

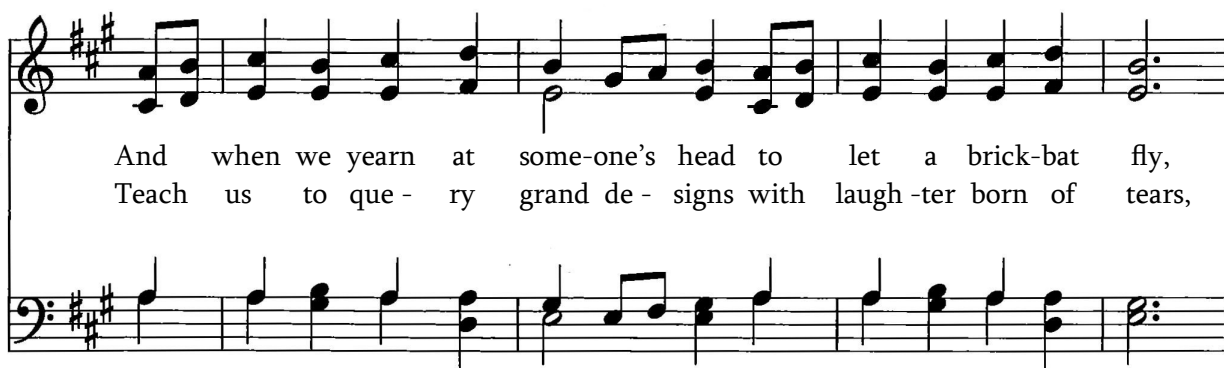
1 When we are tempt-ed in our pride to diz - zy heights of sin,
2 When cher-ished in - sti - tu - tions stand be - fore your throne of grace,



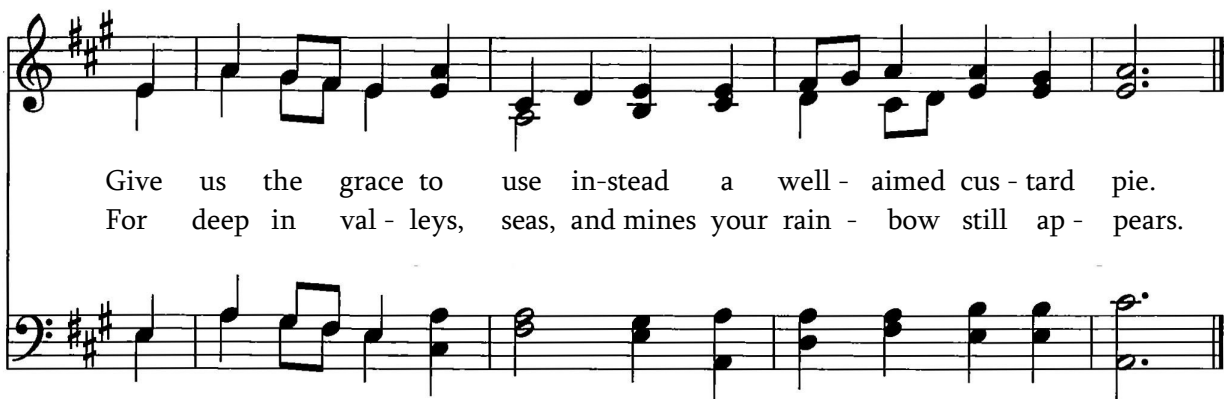
Be - neath our feet, O Lord, pro-vide a ripe ba - na - na skin.
