



ADVENT STUDY DETAILS:

In *Incarnation:* Rediscovering the Significance of Christmas, we'll join author, biblical scholar Adam Hamilton as he examines the names of Christ used by the gospel writers, exploring the historical and personal significance of his birth.

His parents gave him the name Jesus. Yet the prophets, the shepherds, the wise men, and the angels addressed Jesus by other names. They called Him Lord, Messiah, Savior, Emmanuel, Light of the World, and Word Made Flesh.

This Advent season in the face of uncertainty and conflict, Christians reclaim the Christ Child who brings us together, heals our hearts, and calls us to bring light into the darkness. Now more than ever, we are being invited to reflect upon the significance of the Christ-child for our lives and world today.




