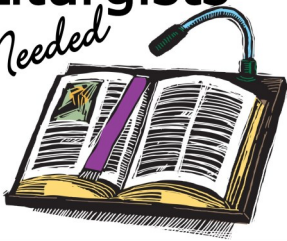




FEBRUARY UPDATES
